# METHODOLOGY MARCH 2012 POLL 

The Reason-Rupe March 2012 poll collected a nationally representative sample of 1200 respondents, aged 18 and older from all 50 states and the District of Columbia using live telephone interviews from March $10^{\text {th }}-20^{\text {th }}$ 2012. The margin of sampling error for this poll is $\pm 3$ percent. Questions on the GOP presidential primary among Republicans and Independent-leaning Republicans have a sample size of 468 , and a $\pm 4.53$ percent margin of error. Interviews were conducted with respondents using both landline (704) and mobile phones (496, including 232 who had no landline telephone phone).
