9.39.120 - Violations.

Any violation of Sections <u>9.39.010</u>—9.39.050 of this code shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) for the first offense; two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for the second offense; and five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for the third and any subsequent offense. The owner of property that is not owner-occupied shall not be subject to any criminal penalties under this chapter unless the owner is the person actually responsible for organizing and/or supervising a party that violates this chapter. Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to preclude the City from exercising any other remedies it may have under the law, including but not limited to, obtaining an injunction. This chapter shall not create any liability for a host or an owner of property, either civilly or criminally, outside of what is in this chapter or is provided elsewhere in local, state or federal law.
