I responded to [REDACTED] for the report of criminal mischief. Upon arrival I met with home owner Larry Martin Jr. who advised that he returned home from work today and found a rock thrown through his dining room window.

Martin advised that he left his residence at 0830 this morning, and knew the window to be in good condition. He returned at approximately 1645 and found a rock thrown through the window. The window had a large hole in the center and shattered glass around the area. The rock was observed in his dining room on the floor. Ptl. Hickman #148 responded and photographed the damages (DM2).

I asked Martin if he had anyone in mind that would have damaged his window. He advised that his neighbor, William Siegle, of [REDACTED] recently started harassing him over his loud vehicle. Martin advised he drives a 2018 BMW which is completely stock, but Siegle insists the vehicle is too loud. Siegle recently had his attorney send Martin a letter for arbitration in which he replied that he would not respond. This letter/response was received/sent two days ago. He found it coincidental that his window was damaged so recently after their dispute.

While on location Siegle was pulling into his drive way. I went over to his driveway and began speaking with him about the incident. Siegle denied any wrongdoing, and insisted that it may have been a wind-tunnel that flung a rock at his house.

As I was waiting for Ptl. Hickman to respond Martin ran out of his residence stating that he called his neighbors who stated they witnessed the entire incident and had it on camera. I met with David Cooper of [REDACTED] who advised that he saw the incident take place along with another neighbor, and provided me video footage from his surveillance camera (DM3). The video showed a white male matching Siegle's clothing in his drive way. He went into the rear compartment of the vehicle, grabbed two items, and threw them at Martin's house with force.

Based on the witness' advising they observed Siegle throw the rocks, the video showing Siegle threw the rocks, and the evidence of rocks in Martin's home I returned to Siegle's house, and placed him under arrest for criminal mischief (handcuffed, double locked, behind the back, searched negative for contraband). He was escorted to the rear prisoner

compartment of vehicle #1706, which was searched (negative for contraband), and secured in with a seatbelt. Siegle was then transported to headquarters for processing; Communications was advised of my starting and ending mileage.

When we arrived at headquarters I secured my weapon and taser in the lock boxes in the sally port. Siegle was then escorted from the rear prisoner compartment of vehicle #1706 into the cell block where he was secured to the holding bench. He remained secured to the bench while I completed processing and paperwork.

Siegle was issued the following:

S2018-0313-895 (Criminal mischief > \$500)

Siegle was provided a courtesy transport back to his residence; Communications was advised of my starting and ending mileage.

Siegle was checked for warrants/CODIS collection (negative).

Siegle was positively identified via Info Cop DMV photograph.
