

## Stands by Albert M. Pear.

At the meeting of the Massachusetts anticompulsory vaccination society in Tremont temple last evening, W. F. Simpson presiding, the case of Albert M. Pear, assistant city clerk of Cambridge, was discussed, and the society voted to sustain him in his contest with the board of health. The continued prosecutions have ceased against Mortimer W. Lawrence of Roxbury, who recently paid his fine for refusing vaccination and defied the board of health to prosecute further. Mr Lawrence has not yet been vaccinated. Forty-one people in Somerville have openly refused vaccination, and no prosecution of them has yet been made, pending decision in the Pear case. The society voted to establish agencies in cities and towns throughout the state.
