

MINISTERS' MEETING.

Represent Swedish, Danish and Norwegian Lutheran Churches.

For the first time in the history of the Scandinavian Lutheran church in the city, the Swedish, Danish and Norwegian Lutheran ministers met in convention last night. The meeting was held at the Swedish Lutheran church on Emerald st in the interest of temperance and to urge support of no-license at the elections in Boston and vicinity.

The first speaker was Rev P. W. Blichfeld of the Danish congregation. He was followed by the pastor of the church, C. F. Johanson, after which there was singing by the choir. Rev Bernard E. Bergesen of the Norwegian Lutheran church on Bartlett st then spoke in his native language, after which there was more singing. Other speakers included Pastor Hansen of the local Danish Lutheran congregation, Pastor **Henning Jacobson** of Cambridge and Pastor C. W. Andeer of East Boston.
