In Senate of the U. States, May 7th 1792

Ordered, That the Secretary of the Treasury do lay before the Senate, at the next session of Congress, a statement of the salaries, fees and emoluments, for one year, ending the 1st day of October next, to be stated quarterly, of every person holding any civil Office or employment under the United States, (except the Judges,) together with the actual disbursements and expenses in the discharge of their respective Offices and employments for the same period; and that he do report the name of every person who shall neglect or refuse to give satisfactory information touching his Office or employment, or the emoluments or disbursements thereof.

The Secretary of the Treasury in obedience to the Order of the Senate of the 7 May, last, respectfully transmits herewith statements of the Salaries, fees and emoluments for one year ending the 1st of October, 1792, of the persons holding civil Offices or employments under the United States (except the Judges) as far as returns have been rendered: together with the disbursements and expenses in the discharge of their respective Offices and employments for the same period:
February 26th 1793.

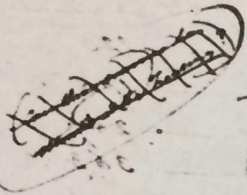
