Be it known that the complainant herein Officer Racioppo, a police officer employed by the New York State University Police Department at Purchase College, New York, accuses the defendant named above of the following offense(s) committed at 735 Anderson Hill Road, Humanities Building, Town of Harrison, New York at about 8:50 p.m. on December 8, 2018.

Count One: THE Offense of AGGRAVATED HARASSMENT IN THE FIRST DEGREE, a violation of Penal Law PL 240.31(3) E-Felony

The Defendant at the above date, time and place did with intent to harass, annoy, threaten or alarm another person, because a belief or perception regarding such person's race, color, national origin, ancestry, gender, religion, religious practice, age, disability or sexual orientation, regardless of whether the belief or perception is correct, etched, painted, drew upon or otherwise placed swastikas, commonly exhibited as the emblem of Nazi Germany, on a building or other real property, public or private, owned by any person, firm or corporation of any public agency or instrumentality, without express permission of the owner or operator of such building or real property.

To wit: The defendant at the above date, time and place, while believing that the above referenced public building and SUNY Purchase College campus are frequented and utilized by members of the Jewish community, did post multiple flyers which featured Swastikas on the bulletin boards of the above referenced public building and on the SUNY Purchase College campus thereby causing alarm, fear, and annoyance to the members of the campus community during the Jewish holiday of Hanukkah.

The above allegations of fact are made by the complainant herein on direct knowledge and upon information and belief, with the source(s) of complainant's information and the grounds for his or her belief being police investigation.

NOTICE: PURSUANT TO THE PENAL LAW, SECTION 210.45, IT IS A CRIME PUNISHABLE AS A CLASS A MISDEMEANOR TO KNOWINGLY MAKE A FALSE STATEMENT HEREIN.
